Description:

Freshwater ecosystems are under increasing pressure around the globe. Population growth, pollution, climate change and weak governance are putting at risk the availability and integrity of waters worldwide. Weak governance in particular has the potential to generate high costs for humans and the environment due to inadequate policies, laws and institutions regulating their conservation and management. IUCN with the support of SDC and in collaboration with key strategic partners has developed a variety of approaches, training packages and tools that have promoted conservation and cooperation in transboundary rivers and lakes in Latin America, Africa and South East Asia.

In this session, participants will reflect on key approaches and tools to mobilise transboundary water cooperation, facilitate dialogues, support the development of agreements, strengthen water institutions and assess the benefits from cooperation required to secure the integrity and conservation of shared freshwater ecosystems.

Speakers will address on the importance of strengthening the capacities of key stakeholders on global legal and institutional frameworks for transboundary water cooperation as a means to ensure nature conservation.
