The programme Mobilizing More for Climate (MoMo4C) develops business cases for ecosystem-based climate adaptation and mitigation initiatives, implemented by IUCN NL, Tropenbos International and WWF in 6 land-scapes in Africa and Southeast Asia. But how can we engage local entrepreneurs? How can MoMo4C ensure that climate solutions are inclusive? How can local communities that are the most vulnerable to the impacts of climate change be not only included but made themselves the drivers of climate resilience in their landscapes? MoMo4C and the CGIAR research program on Forests, Trees and Agroforestry (FTA), analysed three successful cases of fostering entrepreneurship among smallholders that work on climate and biodiversity solutions in three of the MoMo4C landscapes. IUCN NL, Tropenbos International and WWF and the implementing partners in the 6 landscapes will share lessons and opportunities drawn from the different cases and discuss implications for upcoming ambitions of the programme.
